Miscarriage support

Sadly, around one fifth of pregnancies end in miscarriage, often in the first three months. Though most women go on to have a successful pregnancy, experiencing miscarriage can be very traumatic.

Response

It is common to feel grief, loss, guilt, anger and sometimes depression when dealing with the shock and sadness of a miscarriage. People grieve in different ways, and for different lengths of time. In coming to terms with the experience, you may find it helps to talk to someone outside your situation.
